The Cape Cod Art Association, founded in 1948, is a non-profit organization consisting of Associate Members, Artist Members, Sponsors and Benefactors.

Its purpose is to promote an appreciation of Fine Art on Cape Cod and to foster an understanding relationship between the workers in the arts and the community.

Membership Categories

Associate Member (\$55)

Anyone may become an Associate Member at any time of the year upon application and payment of the annual Membership fee.

As an Associate Member you become eligible to discounts on all classes and workshops offered by the Cape Cod Art Association. Also, some activities such as the 'Village Painters' plein air group and 'Art in the Village' festival are open to Members only.

As an Associate Member you will also receive 12 issues of the 'Palette', which is CCAA's newsletter. This is a 4-page letter that keeps Members informed about CCAA business, publicizes Members accomplishments and exhibits plus much more.

Artist Member (\$65)

To become an Artist Member you must submit a portfolio of five pieces of your recent works. A panel of three judges, overseen by one of the Directors, reviews the work. Portfolio reviews are conducted periodically through out the year.

As an Artist Member you have **all** the benefits of an Associate Member plus:

- You may enter your work into 7 Artist Member exhibits where your work will be displayed and offered for sale.
- You may put 3 works in the Gallery Gift Shop where they will be offered for sale
- You may offer for sale prints of your work, which will be displayed in both Galleries and the Gallery Gift Shop
- You may also offer for sale note cards of your work,

We would not be able to provide a broad offering of art education and exhibition opportunities to emerging artists without the generous support of our donors who sponsor awards, contribute to our Endowment Fund, provide scholarships and give unrestricted funds for new classes and improvements to the building. Each year, our benefactors will be highlighted in our exhibit program. Please consider an additional, tax-exempt gift to support our mission of supporting emerging artists on Cape Cod.

Memberships run from January 1st to December 31st and renew annually. Members joining after October 1st will have their membership run thru December 31st of the following year.
