## Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary Outing

We will be having an outing to the Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary on Thursday, September 14th. All camera club members can arrive anytime after noon-time to take pictures. For free admission, they need to identify themselves at the front desk with their CCAACC membership cards. The Sanctuary is located off of Route 6A in Wellfleet (close to the Eastham border).

Our camera club members will have free access to the facility and sanctuary through the day, but we must be off the sanctuary trails by dark.

There will be a brief sanctuary orientation by Bob Prescott or one of his staff before we set out. It will take place around

1:00 p.m., We will shoot around the Sanctuary through sunset, then convene in the new Headquarters building for a presentation by one of our members,
